Panel Discussion

The Political Struggles in Turkey and UK

Widespread protests erupted in Turkey on March 19 following the arrest of Istanbul mayor Ekrem Imamoglu and other opposition members. The situation escalated further when hundreds of students were arrested, revealing the increasingly authoritarian nature of the government and its judiciary. The government narrative, interwoven with nationalism and religious discourse, attempts to shape society into a single mould, suppressing diverse voices and treating criticism as a threat. The space for opposition is shrinking, while far-right ideas and practices are spreading and becoming normalised.

In the UK, with the increasing antiimmigration sentiment, the political centre is shifting to the right; while the discourse of "British values" is rising like an exclusionary shield. In this environment, government's latest immigration white paper thickens the fortress walls and strengthens the ground for the farright. However, resistance persists in the form of solidarity with the Palestinian people, protests against Israel's attacks in Gaza, ongoing strikes, marches, and the search for political alternatives.

In both Turkey and the UK, the fight against darkness is not a choice but a historical necessity. We hope that our festival, with its panel discussion and other activities, will be a means for this fight to be further developed and carried forward.
